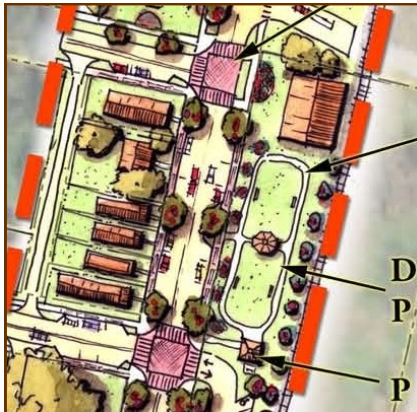
SPOTLIGHT ON METCALFE

In partnership with the National Trust for Historic Preservation, Thomasville Landmarks, Inc. is preserving places throughout the Thomas County area — communities like Springhill, Grooverville, Metcalfe and Meigs are important parts of our history; their preservation will enhance our future. These Places Matter: they represent a history and heritage, a sense of community and place...these are the places where your grandparents lived, you played as a child, and your children will get married. **Help us meet the challenge** and preserve this way of life and these memories for present and future generations.

Working with the Metcalfe community and Thomas County government, Landmarks secured a \$150,000 DOT grant for streetscape improvements, with the understanding we would raise some matching funds locally. The DOT grant money won't be released until this local match is raised. The Williams Family Foundation issued a local challenge grant of \$35,000 and we have already raised \$8,000.

What is this project about?

The goal of the Downtown Metcalfe Streetscape Phase I project is to enhance the infrastructure, aesthetics and pedestrian safety in order to lay the foundation for further improvements, such as business development, truck scale relocation, and resident and visitor amenities. At left is a portion of the initial concept plan submitted to the DOT, showing the main block of downtown. The depot is in the upper right of the image. The park below the depot is perhaps a future phase once the scales can be moved. Phase I includes "traffic calming" intersections to slow traffic without stop signs or speed bumps, trees, lighting, sidewalks, and landscaping. The Metcalfe Community Association will be intimately involved in the landscape design and other matters. Thomasville Landmarks and the Metcalfe Heritage Society will manage and facilitate the grant and community meetings.
